These equivalences are only taken to be a guide and as a suggestion in order to aid partner countries around the world to find equivalences of Sciences Po grading systems. It should be noted that the average grade of a Sciences Po student is situated around 11-13/20 and roughly 50% of students obtain 12/20 or over when enrolled on the French national diploma ; foreign and visiting students may expect slightly more than this.
