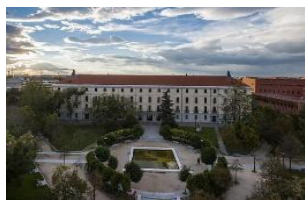

Some general rules must be taken into account when choosing your courses:

- Most courses are ONLY OFFERED in one Semester.
- Minimum: 6 ECTS for Semester / Maximum: 30 ECTS for Semester.
- Erasmus+ students can only select courses from the School that they have been admitted to.
- Non-European students can select any of the courses from ALL the Schools.

Most in-demand courses or most impacted courses:

Although our offer in English-taught courses is very wide, there are some of them which are **highly demanded**. We recommend partner institutions to emphasize course flexibility to their students and bring some additional courses approved in case their first options are not always available. They should agree these reserve choices with their home academic advisors.

Institutional Grading System	NO PRESENTADO = ABSENT : The student registered for the subject but did not sit the final exam FAIL (FROM 0 TO 4.9): Considerable further work is required. The student must resit the exam PASS (FROM 5 TO 6.9): Satisfactory knowledge of the contents GOOD (FROM 7 TO 8.9): Students who demonstrate a thorough knowledge of the course contents EXCELLENT (FROM 9 TO 10): Outstanding performance HONOURS MH (+9)*: Exceptional performance * This grade is quite rare and can only be granted to a limited number of students per group (typically to up to 5% of the students)
