

LIST OF LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY DOCUMENTS ACCEPTED FOR

ADMISSION TO THE DU INTERNATIONAL (English track)

ENGLISH TRACK / Parcours Anglophone :

All students must attest a B2 level minimum in English.

Students will not have to provide proof of language proficiency if English is their first language.

If English is not their first language, language proficiency is required :

- TOEFL (score of minimum 72 points)
- TOEIC : 785 points
- IELTS level B2 minimum (overall score 5.5)
- Other equivalent test
- An official transcript indicating that they have studied in English language
- An academic reference written by a professor, the Faculty or Department at the home university

For the obligatory French class, students must also indicate their level of language.

If they have already studied French language, students must provide :

- DELF, TCF test results (or other equivalent test)
- An official transcript indicating that they have studied French

If they have never studied French or do not have these documents, students are asked to selfasses their level according to the European Language Levels Grid : <u>https://europa.eu/europass/en/common-european-framework-reference</u>
