ACCEPTED LANGUAGE CERTIFICATION DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO DU INTERNATIONAL (English track)

All students must demonstrate a minimum B2 level in English.

Students will not need to provide proof of language proficiency if English is their native language.

Diplomas and certificates are valid for two years from the date of issue.

Documents accepted for exchange students :

- TOEFL (72 points)
- TOEIC (785 points)
- IELTS (5.5)
- Cambridge English test
- Other equivalent test
- Diploma delivered in English language
- An official transcript indicating that they have studied in English language
- An academic reference written by a professor, the Faculty or Department at the home university

Documents accepted for independant students (« Free Movers ») :

- TOEFL (72 points)
- TOEIC (785 points)
- IELTS (5.5)
- Cambridge English test
- Degree delivered in English language

For the obligatory French as a Foreign Language class, students must also indicate their level of language. If they have already studied French, students must provide a language test or official transcript indicating that they have studied French.

If they have never studied French or do not have these documents, students are asked to self-asses their level according to the <u>Common European Framework of Reference for Language skills | Europass</u>.
